

## Teaching notes

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### Paper version

- Before the lesson, cut out and laminate the cards. Give a set of cards to the children and help them to read the names. Discuss the fact that names begin with capital letters. Children are not expected to be able to read all of these words so concentrate on emphasising the initial sound of each name.
- Now explain to the children that they are going to play a matching game. The children turn all the cards face down in front of them. They take it in turns to turn two cards over at a time. A child can keep the pair of cards if:
  - the two cards reveal two words that match
  - or*
  - the two pictures match
  - or*
  - the cards reveal a picture and a word that match.

Encourage the children to read the cards as they are turned face up. If the cards don't match they should be turned face down again and the next child takes their turn.
