


Teaching notes




- Before the lesson, cut out and laminate two sets of the egg cards on the following pages. Help the children read the decodable words taken from the text.
- Now explain to the children that they are going to turn all the cards face down and take it in turns to turn two cards over at a time. If they reveal two words that match they get to keep those eggs!
- Encourage the children to read the cards as they are turned over. If the cards don't match they must be turned over again and the next child takes their turn.

Decodable words used:
