



This activity is linked to Letters and Sounds: Phase 2, Sets 1-5.

On the following pages are eight bingo cards and 15 letter cards. These need to be photocopied onto card, cut out and laminated.


You will also need four coloured counters per child and a bag to keep the letter cards in.


- Read the story with the children.
- Give each child a bingo card. Explain to the children that they are going to play bingo using phonemes from the words in the book.
- Take one bingo letter at a time out of the bag and sound it out to the children. If the children can match the sound to a letter on their bingo card, they cover that letter with a counter.
- The winner is the first child to cover all their letters.
- Now ask the children to try to make a word from the story using three of the letters on their card.
 Each card contains at least one 'hidden' CVC word from the story.
