

Teaching notes



- Prior to the lesson prepare blank word banks for each of the following: food, games, clothes and venues.
- Look at the pictures on pages 19-21. List the food and drinks that the children can see in the pictures, on the relevant word bank.
 Sound out and blend any words with tricky spelling patterns.
- Discuss with the class which foods they would like to have if they were having a party. List some of their ideas.
- Next discuss further party ideas:

What games they would they like to play at a party?

What would they like their guests to wear?

What time would they have their party?

Where would they have their party?

Again, add their suggestions to the relevant word banks.

• Children then complete the party planner, either individually or as a group, using ideas from the word banks.
