


Teaching notes



- Resources necessary: glue sticks, scissors, photocopies of the pyramid net on card (one per child), and pencils. Plus an additional teacher set of equipment.
- After sharing the story, return to pages 2-5.
 Explain that Nadim's book shows a net of a pyramid. Explain to the children that they are going to make their own model of a pyramid using a net. These could then be placed together to create a class Egyptian scene!
- Provide each child with a copy of the pyramid net, scissors and a glue stick. Provide oral instructions on how to create the pyramid whilst constructing a 'teacher model' at the same time. Allow time for the children to complete each step before moving on.
 - **1.** Cut around the net being careful not to cut off the tabs (these are labelled 'glue here').
 - 2. Fold along each of the solid lines.
 - **3.** Glue along each of the tabs, labelled 'glue here'.
 - **4.** Firmly press the glued tabs to an unglued edge.
- Children now use the writing frame to complete a set of written instructions explaining how to make a model of a pyramid.

Nadim wants to make a pyramid. Using scissors and glue, carefully cut along the dotted lines and make your own pyramid!
