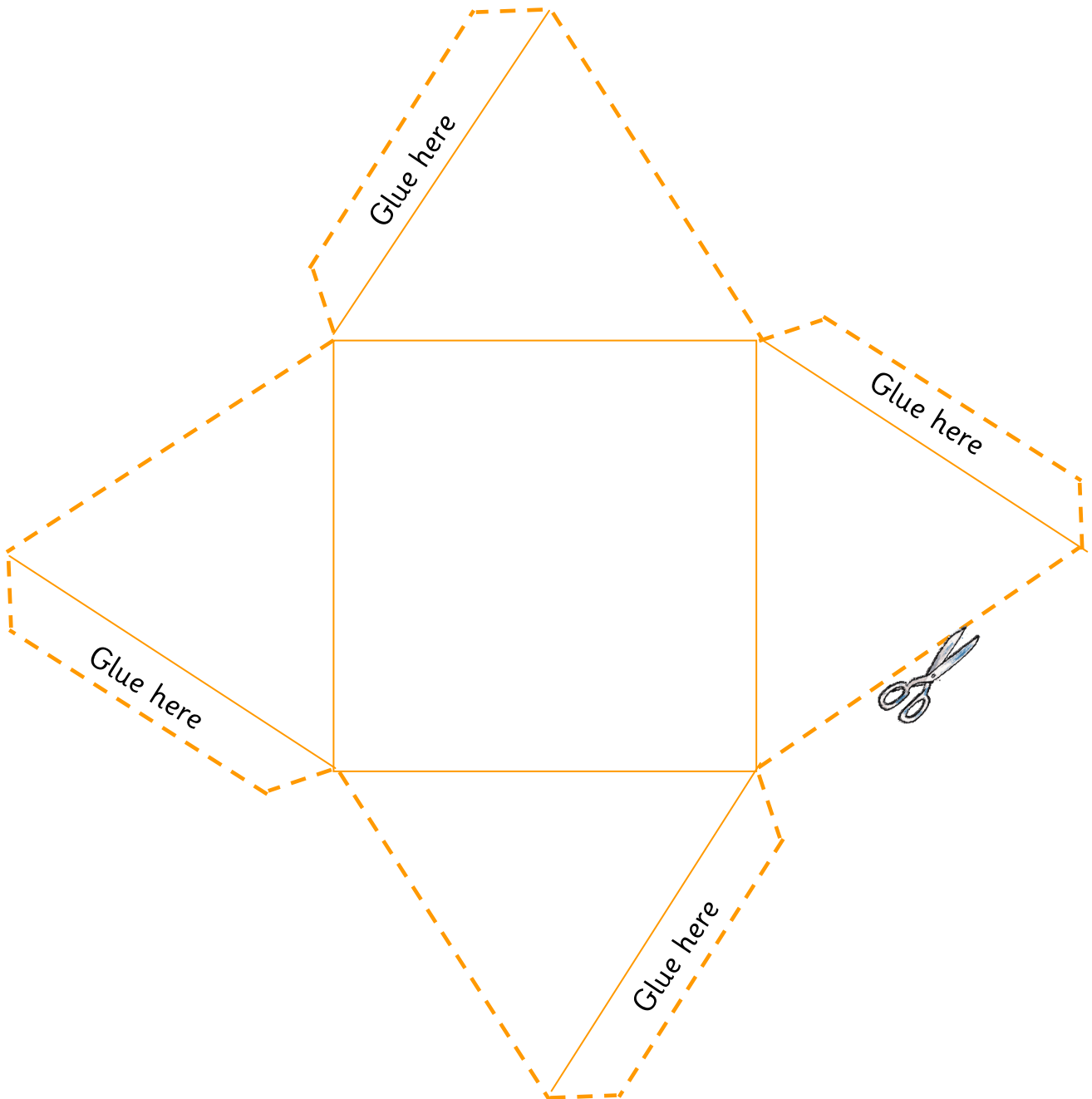


Teaching notes



- Resources necessary: glue sticks, scissors, photocopies of the pyramid net on card (one per child), and pencils. Plus an additional teacher set of equipment.
- After sharing the story, return to pages 2-5. Explain that Nadim's book shows a net of a pyramid. Explain to the children that they are going to make their own model of a pyramid using a net. These could then be placed together to create a class Egyptian scene!
- Provide each child with a copy of the pyramid net, scissors and a glue stick. Provide oral instructions on how to create the pyramid whilst constructing a 'teacher model' at the same time. Allow time for the children to complete each step before moving on.
 1. Cut around the net being careful not to cut off the tabs (these are labelled 'glue here').
 2. Fold along each of the solid lines.
 3. Glue along each of the tabs, labelled 'glue here'.
 4. Firmly press the glued tabs to an unglued edge.
- Children now use the writing frame to complete a set of written instructions explaining how to make a model of a pyramid.

Nadim wants to make a pyramid. Using scissors and glue, carefully cut along the dotted lines and make your own pyramid!
