If a boy chooses he can go into the army or navy.	Our city is run as a democracy where all citizens can have their say. Excluding slaves of course!
Boys live away from their parents and are not given enough food or clothing. We believe this teaches them how to survive, even if that is by stealing!	Only rich girls can be educated, but only at home — they can not attend school. We teach them about spinning and weaving.
Our boys must join the army!	A wife is the property of her husband.
Girls are taught to read and write.	Our kings (yes we have two of them) make up the rules of our city.
