## **Teaching notes**

**Starter:** Launch the interactive Sequencing starter from <a href="www.teachitlanguages.co.uk">www.teachitlanguages.co.uk</a> by entering the resource number 24917 into the quick search box and clicking the yellow star icon. Students have to drag the frequency phrases into order, e.g. from 'nie' to 'immer'. There may be more than one correct order!

**Slide 1:** What do students use their mobile phones for most often? Ask the class to work in pairs to note down ideas in German, related to the images, using dictionaries if needed.

Slide 2: Suggested answers will appear one by one for students to compare with their own list, tick off and translate.

Slide 3: Students use the two questions to conduct a survey of six other students, making notes in German on the grid provided on p.1 about how often mobiles are used for each activity. They can use the slide for support with the questions and with the frequency phrases, if needed. They could then draw a pie chart or write up their results in German, according to ability.

Slide 4: An extension activity to translate five sentences into German. Answers will appear on clicking.
